Gravel

Start by adding the bottom layer and work your way up. The moss, between the charcoal and the potting soil, helps to keep the soil from washing down into the charcoal and bottom gravel. Additional moss can be added on top of the potting soil or just cover the top with decorative gravel.

Tips on How To Care For a Terrarium

Put your terrarium where it will get plenty of bright light but out of direct sun.


Water sparingly, mist often.



Watch your plants - if they're beginning to wilt, add water. Always water lightly.

Remove dying leaves as soon as you notice them, to avoid rot and fungus. Pinch tips as your plants grow, to control height and to create bushier, more attractive plants.
