

# New & Exciting Houseplants



## Philodendrons (500+ varieties)

Variety - Pink Princess (*Erubescens*)

- ◇ Easy to care for "rare" houseplant, and it's becoming much easier to find!
- ◇ Medium to bright indirect light will provide faster growth and more variegation—direct light is okay but only for a few hours in the morning
- ◇ Water when soil is 60-75% dry - sensitive to overwatering!

## Murdannia loriformis

(Angel Grass)

- ◇ An exotic and "rare" houseplant with medicinal properties!
- ◇ Bright indirect sunlight is best - do not place in direct sunlight
- ◇ Water when soil is 25-50% dry

## Alocasias (Very trendy!)

Variety - Lauterbachiana

- ◇ Stunning, but sometimes difficult houseplant
- ◇ Very bright indirect light is needed, but do not place in direct sunlight as the leaves can easily burn
- ◇ Water when soil is 25% dry - alocasias are sensitive to both over and under watering



## Rhaphidophora Decursiva

(Dragon Tail)

- ◇ Hard to find, giant climbing houseplant - you're definitely going to need a trellis!
- ◇ Medium to bright filtered or indirect light is best, but it can survive in low light
- ◇ Water when soil is 25-50% dry

## Hoyas (900+ varieties)

Variety - Speckled/Pubicalyx

- ◇ Often grown for their star shaped, fragrant flowers
- ◇ Medium to bright indirect light - can tolerate lower light, but will be less likely to flower
- ◇ Water when soil is 100% dry—very sensitive to overwatering!
